The REDCA provides a forum for people with an interest of the compliance of radio equipment with the regulations and technical standards in the European Economic Area. In particular formed under the requirements of the Radio Equipment Directive 2014/53/EU specifically for Article 26.11 and Article 38 for Notified Bodies.

Members as of February 2018 are (231) and a number pending acceptance at the next REDCA meeting: they all need to follow the aims and objectives set out in the Associations Rules and Constitution.

The annual fee for REDCA Membership is €600



Originates from previous associations active under the applicable EU Directives at that time:

<u>ADLNB</u>: Association of Designated Laboratories and Notified bodies, active under the TTE Directive (Telecommunications Terminal Equipment Directive 91/263/EEC)

<u>*R&TTE-CA:*</u> Compliance association under the Radio and Terminal Equipment Directive 1999/5/EC. When the R&TTE Directive has been replaced with the RED this previous association was renamed into REDCA



What does REDCA do?

- REDCA publishes Technical Guidance Notes (12) and reference Doc's
  - See website <u>http://www.redca.eu</u>
- The Association meets twice a year in a location within the EEA
  - Members only
  - With Representatives of the EU Commission, ECC, ETSI, ADCO RED and authorities from MRA countries.
- Has a mail server for members where they can ask questions that will trigger answers and comments from the experts within the Association
